From **THE DIRECTOR**

The bee starts very normally, with a colorful gang of youngsters ready to compete. The thought of friendships are either out of the question or too good to be true. The main goal is to take it all and move on to national's as the Putnam County champ. But, as our story continues we watch the spellers (some reluctantly) start to develop connections with one another. We watch as each speller introduces themselves and what brought them to the bee. And with every elimination and *cough cough* unexpected "visitor", we watch the spellers find the similarities within each other. Looks like maybe they'll be able to "live with second" if their friend gets first?

On the other side of the spectrum we have our three adults. And these people have absolutely NO idea what they signed up for. Ranging from an affluent corporate demeanor to the edginess of ex-con, these three use their personalities and work together to keep some kind of peace amongst the kids. But, is the bee just for the benefit of the spellers? I think that everyone has a reason and a purpose for being there, and that includes the ones who are running the show.

Finn and Sheinkin's work of art does an amazing job of encapsulating not only the parts of adolescence that we'd rather forget about (puberty, bullying, family struggles), but also the moments that we love to remember. Spelling Bee uses humor and improvisation to highlight the awkwardness and heartbreak of growing up. While Sheinkin's orchestrations help to tell the stories of six young spellers and three overwhelmed adults, all of them are on a character-shaping journey in the setting of the 25th annual local spelling bee.
