### From THE DIRECTOR

I've been a fan of Woody Allen's work as far as I can remember. From movies like *Sleeper* and *Bananas* to his many humor books, he has often made me laugh out loud with his absurdity and physical comedy.

The first time I was exposed to Allen (phrasing!) as a playwright was when my high school produced the Cold War farce *Don't Drink the Water*. Even though the play was first produced several years before, the Cold War between the Americans and the Soviets was still going strong, and the threat of nuclear annihilation was still a remote possibility. Allen found humor in the situation while not diminishing it, like other comedies of that era such as *Dr. Strangelove* and *The Russians Are Coming The Russians Are Coming*.

This play has several stock characters we can all identify; the bumbling bureaucrat who has no business being in charge, the "meet cute" couple, the boorish American tourists, just to name a few. But in front of the backdrop of a serious international conflict, they bring levity to an otherwise tense situation.

Thanks to this awesome cast and crew for bringing out the best of their talents to tell this hilarious story!


