

## Meet **THE CAST**



**Derrick Parker** (Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.) has worked as an actor for more than three decades. During that time, he has had lead roles in such shows as: *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *Othello*, *Hamlet*, *The Cherry Orchard*, *Driving Miss Daisy*, *The Boys Next Door*, *Topdog/Underdog* and *The Winter's Tale*. Derrick studied acting at East Carolina University and earned his MFA in acting at the University of San Diego/Old Globe Theatre. Moving toward on-screen work, Derrick wrote/directed/produced a feature length film about exoneration, *From Faith to Freedom*.



**Olushola Fagbamila** (Camae) is a Nigerian-American actress and designer born on October 18th in early nineties Stockton, California. Beyond the theater, television and cinema she has expanded her expertise into the design realm by contributing her creativity as a costume designer on set of various stage and film productions.
