From **THE DIRECTOR**

Beetlejuice is an iconic character. He's loud, dirty, mean, borderline evil, and by all accounts, someone we probably shouldn't like. Yet somehow, we love him. We want to say his name three times and hang out with him. He was my daughter's first best friend when she was three and met him at Universal Studios. And audiences around the world have been falling in love with this mischievous demon since the eighties. A character who, beneath all the chaos and questionable behavior, is really just looking for a very human connection. And hey, aren't we all?



I loved the movie and the animated series that followed when I was a kid, but I didn't think much about *Beetlejuice* during my adult life. Sure, we'd occasionally rewatch the movie around Halloween, but he wasn't exactly a household name in our family. Then the world shut down.

Everything felt bleak, and we were all trying our best to find ways to keep smiling. That's when we discovered *Beetlejuice the Musical* as a family. Here was a show about death that, much like the title character, we probably shouldn't love as much as we do. But somehow, laughing at the absurdity of death was exactly what we needed at that moment.

Eddie Perfect, Scott Brown, and Anthony King took Tim Burton's strange and unusual characters and brought them to another level. Beneath the outrageous costumes, big musical numbers, and laugh-out-loud comedy is a story about grief, loss, loneliness, family, and finding the strength to move forward. It's like watching a live-action cartoon, completely ridiculous one moment and surprisingly heartfelt the next.

There is so much sadness in life. So, for the next hour, we hope we can give you permission to laugh at it, smile through it, and maybe even find a little joy in the darkness.

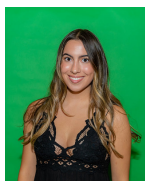

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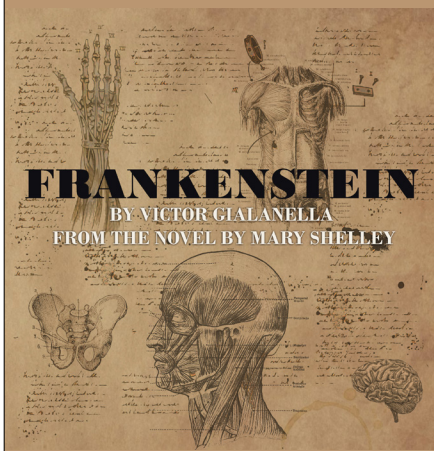


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
